




BROWNSTONE STREET

6,300 sqft

Originally constructed in the 1930s, this block of upscale residential walkups captures the unique personalities of many famous cities. The timeless qualities of its Brownstone apartments and daylight basement units make this façade street a favorite for feature film, music videos and television productions. *Argo*, *The West Wing*, *Pretty Little Liars* and *Friends* have all called Brownstone Street their home. Located in the heart of the studio, Brownstone Street is the center of all the bustling activity you find on a working lot. Since it is adjacent to the Steven J Ross Theater, it is the perfect pre or post function space for a daytime meeting or evening award show.


Did you know: Brownstone Street is considered the oldest backlot at the studio.





COMMISSARY FINE DINING 2,600 sqft

The Warner Bros. Commissary Fine Dining Room is the gathering spot of the Studio's producers, directors, executives and talent. It is the exact place where Hollywood royalty has met and dined for years. The sophisticated ambiance imparted by its sleek stone floors and multitiered seating lends itself to a wide range of functions. The private dining rooms and French doors-leading to a charming patio-area perfect for intimate Hollywood dinners and elegant cocktail receptions. The dining room has been an ideal location for television shows such as *The Rookie*, *The Mentalist* and *Chuck*.






HENNESY STREET

13,000 sqft

Redesigned by Dale Hennesy for the 1984 movie *Annie*, this New York tenement row boasts four-story facades, alleyways, fire escapes and large storefront windows. Hennesy Street has been home to such diverse television shows as *Entourage*, *Friends*, *Sex in the City*; and features to include *Spiderman*, *Rent* and 3 films from the Batman franchise. Like any Hollywood production, this street can be dressed to re-create almost any era you desire. Additionally, Hennesy Street has many large interiors for interactive activities and guest seating. Corporate logos and branded signage can even be incorporated into its storefront windows to customize the look for your special event.





MIDWEST STREET

33,000 sqft

With its small-town square, gazebo, courthouse, steeple church and street-level storefronts, Midwest Street can become "Anytown, USA" for your next special event. A small tree-lined residential street meanders off the town square and is highlighted by four different homes. You may recognize Midwest Street from such productions as *The Music Man*, *Rebel Without a Cause* and *Bonnie and Clyde;* as well as the television shows *The Dukes of Hazzard, Gilmore Girls, Pretty Little Liars* and *Grease Live*. Midwest Street is the largest backlot set at Warner Bros. and has been the home to large charity fundraisers, Hollywood weddings and major corporate events. With usable interior facades, you can really bring this custom town to life.













Did you know: Midwest Street has been home to two of James Dean's three movies.








NEW YORK STREET

28,000 sqft

Warner Bros.' very own slice of the "Big Apple" can be found on its most famous backlot, New York Street. Originally built in the 1930s for classic Hollywood gangster pictures starring James Cagney, Humphrey Bogart and Edward G. Robinson; this downtown business district can be dressed to represent virtually any major city in the world. It's been featured in movies as diverse as A Star Is Born, Jersey Boys, Blade Runner and for a pivotal scene in The Artist. New York Street is the location for the popular television show Shameless, and served as the ambulance entrance for the television series *E.R.*: complete with an elevated commuter railway, Chicago's famous 'L'. With large main stage and green room capabilities for special events, New York Street is the perfect home for numerous award shows and gala receptions.








STEVEN J. ROSS THEATER 12,000 sqft
